Dear Patient,

We are writing to notify you of an upcoming change in Dr. Lubinski's plans at North Olympic Healthcare Network (NOHN).

Dr. Lubinski has recently decided to pursue a different practice plan beginning at the end of January 2017. While she has enjoyed her primary care duties at NOHN, she has elected to transition to a different capacity here by providing much needed urgent care access while developing a group visit model for the clinic instead. This would allow her to spend more time focusing on her interests in patient education, and for our patients to benefit from that interest.


We are actively developing that model, but we will not have definitive details for a several months yet. In the meantime, she will be scheduled for urgent care access only, rather than primary care panel activities.


