As part of the organization's mission to offer whole-person care, we are looking to hire Behavioral Health Specialists to work within an integrated, multidisciplinary model in our primary care clinic. The Behavioral Health Specialist's duties consist of providing brief assessment, intervention, and onsite consultation to the primary care team regarding psychiatric/psychosocial concerns and health behavior change. While coordination of care is part of the job duties, a majority of the Behavioral Health Specialist's activities will be focused on providing clinical interventions according to evidence-based treatment modalities.

Port Angeles is located on the north Olympic Peninsula, approximately 2 hours west of Seattle, and 90 minutes by ferry from Victoria, British Columbia.
