POSITION SUMMARY

This position is for a general dentist in a community health center dental practice. This position will provide a wide range of oral health services and treatments to patients of all ages. This position will work in conjunction with other dental providers and staff to ensure all patients receive effective, efficient and optimal dental care, while also creating and exemplifying an environment for a superior patient experience.

PRIMARY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Diagnose and provide appropriate dental treatment plans to patients to include discussion and explanation of treatment plans with parents and/or guardians to their satisfaction and understanding
- Providing emergency dental care when needed
- Educate patients, parents and/or guardians on the importance of maintaining proper oral health
- Communicate with clinical and administrative support team regarding patient treatment plans, required follow up visits and referrals to specialty dentists
- Administer local anesthesia in appropriate amounts to patients to control pain during dental procedures
- Prescribe medications necessary and appropriate
- Administer local anesthesia for pain control during dental procedures when appropriate
- Carefully document all medications, diagnoses, consultations, treatment plans, etc. into the electronic dental record and adhere to HIPAA regulations
- Attend required continuing education courses related to the dental profession
- Practice and follow infection control and OSHA regulations
- Other duties as assigned
- Uphold the mission, values, and principles of the organization
- Collaborate when needed with other providers both internal and external as part of a patient care team model
